## Responding to the reading

Today is Ascension Sunday – the day of the Easter-season when Christians celebrate and mark Jesus' ascension into heaven – we've just read Luke's account of this story.

You are offered four reflection or discussion questions based on some of the themes that emerge from today's gospel reading. Take some time, reflect on your own, make some notes, and then see if you can find someone you trust to talk about all this with. If other people you know are using this resource, why not arrange to meet up or speak on the phone this week about the questions, your responses, and pray for each other as you explore what the ascension might mean for you.

1. Understanding and Openness: In what ways can I foster a deeper understanding of my faith and how my faith relates to some of the big issues in the world today? How

open am I to new interpretations of the Bible and new ways of thinking about the challenges of our time?

2. Mission and Inclusivity: Jesus' directive to preach repentance and forgiveness to all nations suggests a call to inclusivity. How can the church or community I am part of better reflect this call, ensuring that we are welcoming and accessible to all, especially those who have felt marginalised or excluded?
3. Transformation and Hope: The ascension of Jesus marks a moment of transformation and the promise of the Holy Spirit. In what ways am I called to play a part in the transformation of my community? How can I be an embodiment of hope?
4. Practical Application: Reflecting on the directive to be witnesses to all nations, what are some practical ways I can live out this mission in my local context? How can I make use of all the resources, skills and passions I have, or am aware of in my community, to help address the needs of those around us and beyond?

- Show me how to be a force for love in my own family and in the families in the community around me. Amen.

### **Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> May**

- Creator God, great shepherd of the sheep, fill me with your hope as I pray. Holy Spirit, give me the strength and courage for this day, fill me with the peace I need, and the joy of being surrounded by your love. Help me to notice where your love is at work in the world, and to get involved where I can.
